Of the 208 schools we contacted in the first round, 15 replied positively to apply our Tobacco Education on their Indigenous students.





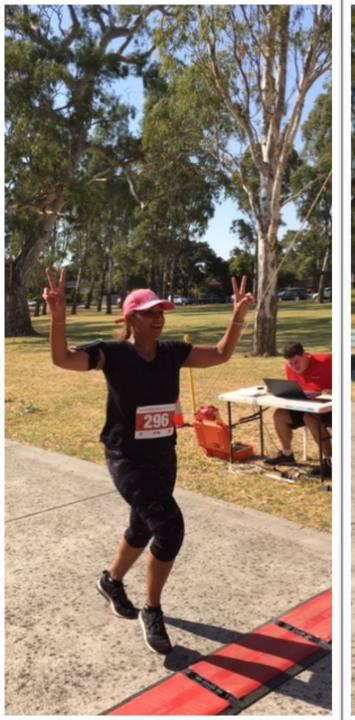
















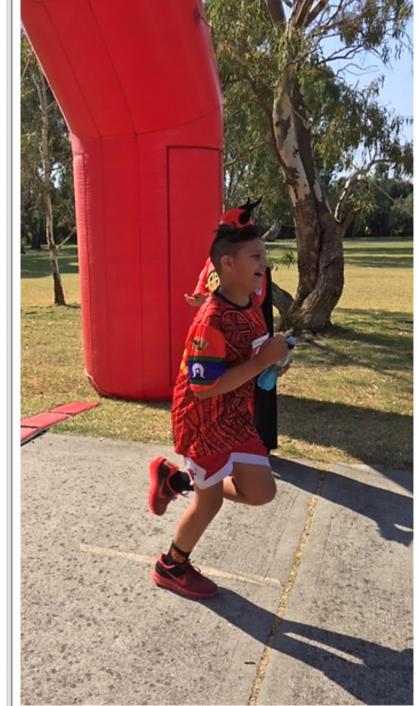
