Let me begin by acknowledging the traditional owners and custodians of Mparntwe (Alice Springs)whose land we are meeting on, the Central Arrente people. I wish to pay respect to their continuing culture and the contribution they make to the life of this city and this region.

I would like to acknowledge that this gathering is being held on the traditional lands of the Central Arrernte people and recognise the strength, resilience and capacity of Central Arrernte people in this land.

For too long now some Indigenous people, and especially men have maintained a state of oppression, whether by choice or circumstance is a matter of perspective and opinion.


