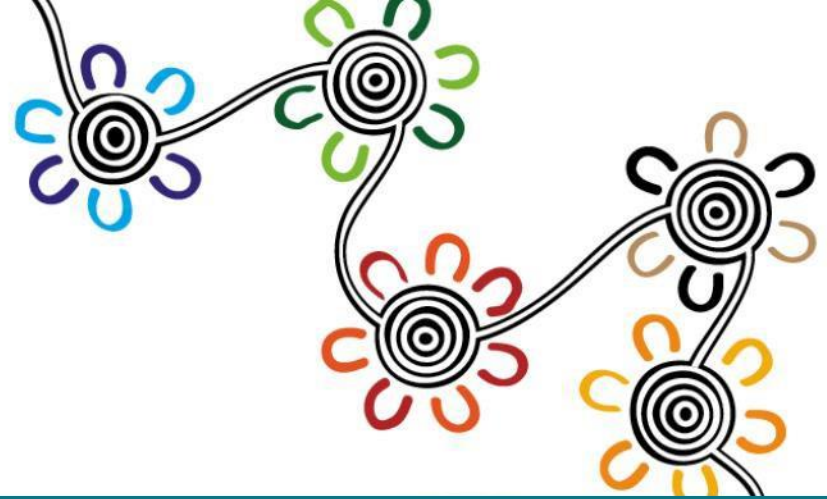

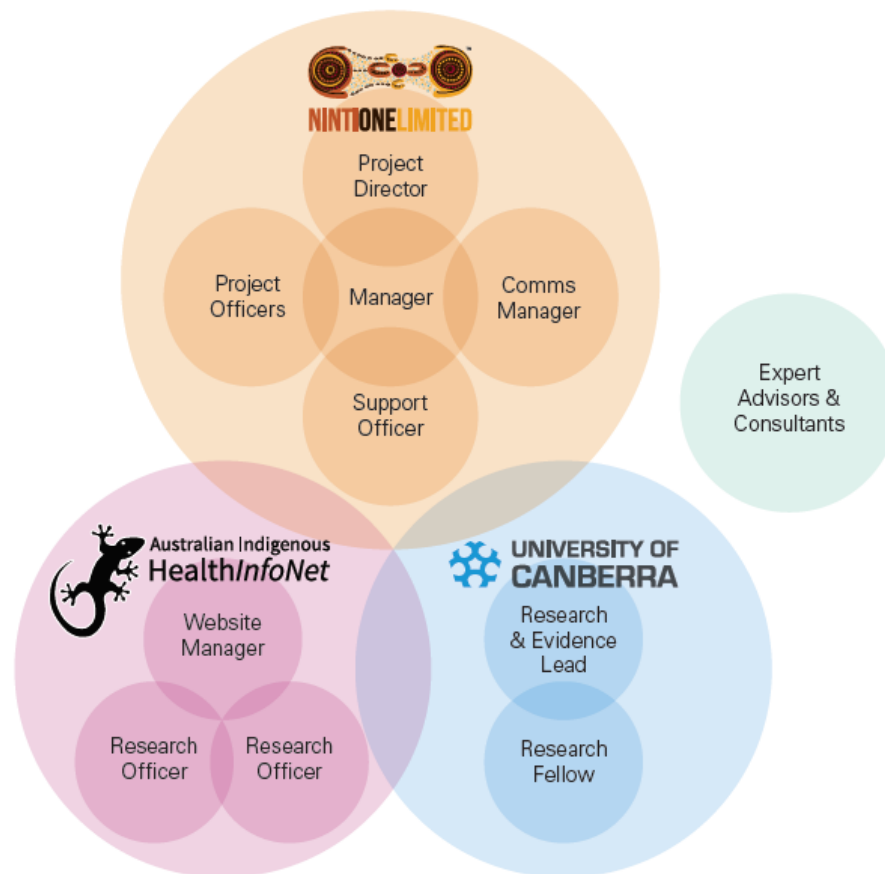

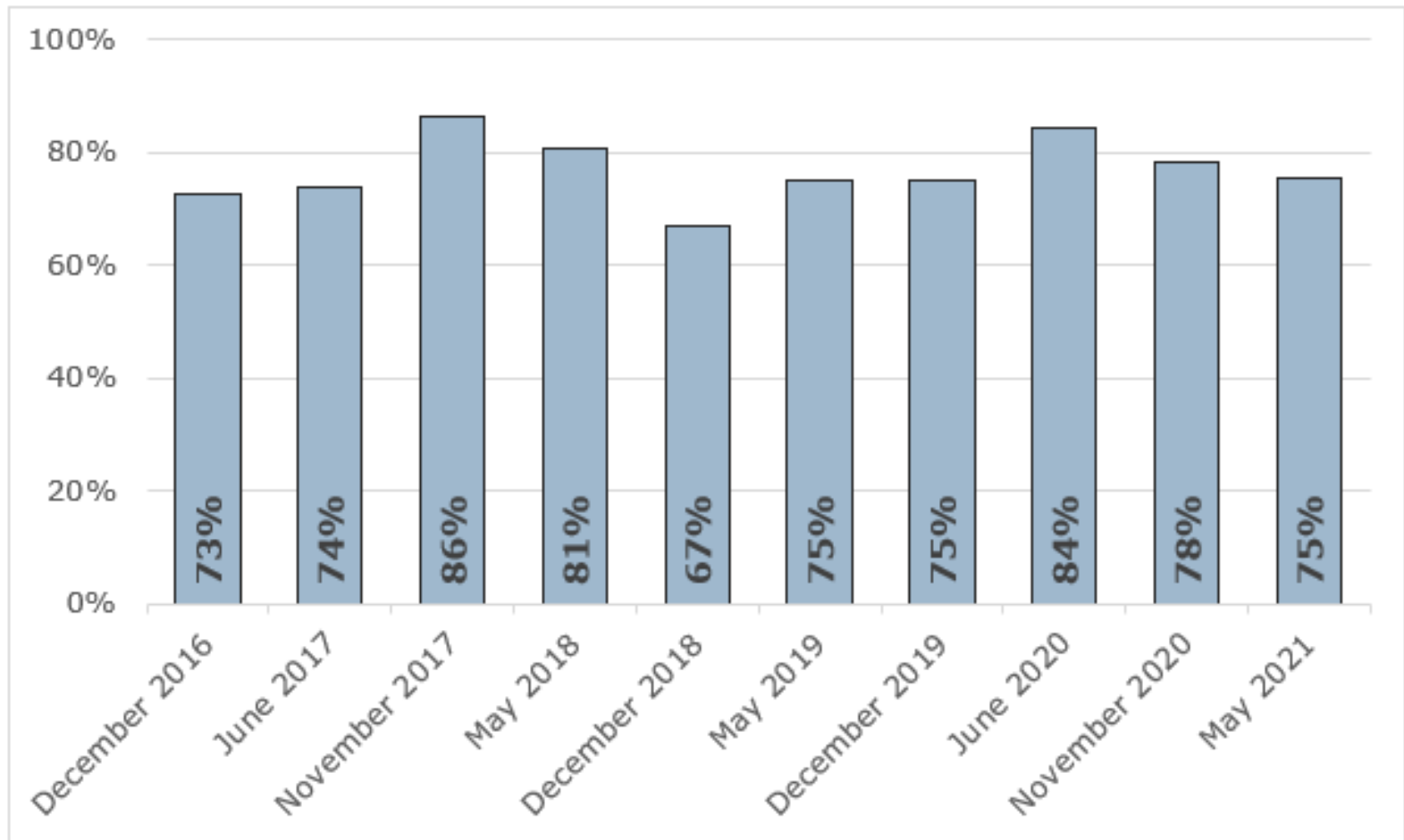

How Does The NBPU Work With Grant Recipients?

The NBPU provides tailored one-on-one support through telephone and web-based services, in addition to site visits where further support is required and will depend on COVID impacting on border closures. The NBPU have established a web-based community of practice and regular communications to share information and resources and resolve issues related to the TIS programme.

The NBPU will organise and deliver a series of workshops in each jurisdiction to be held each year

During the reporting period, three TIS Workshops were delivered from March 2021

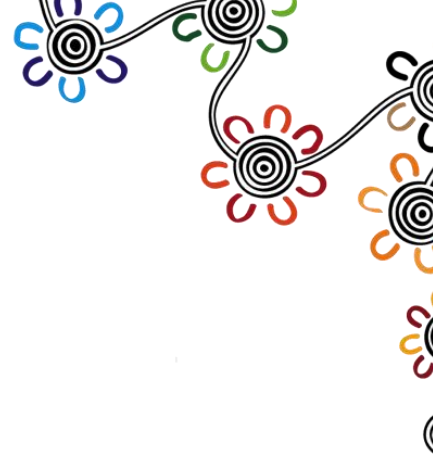
