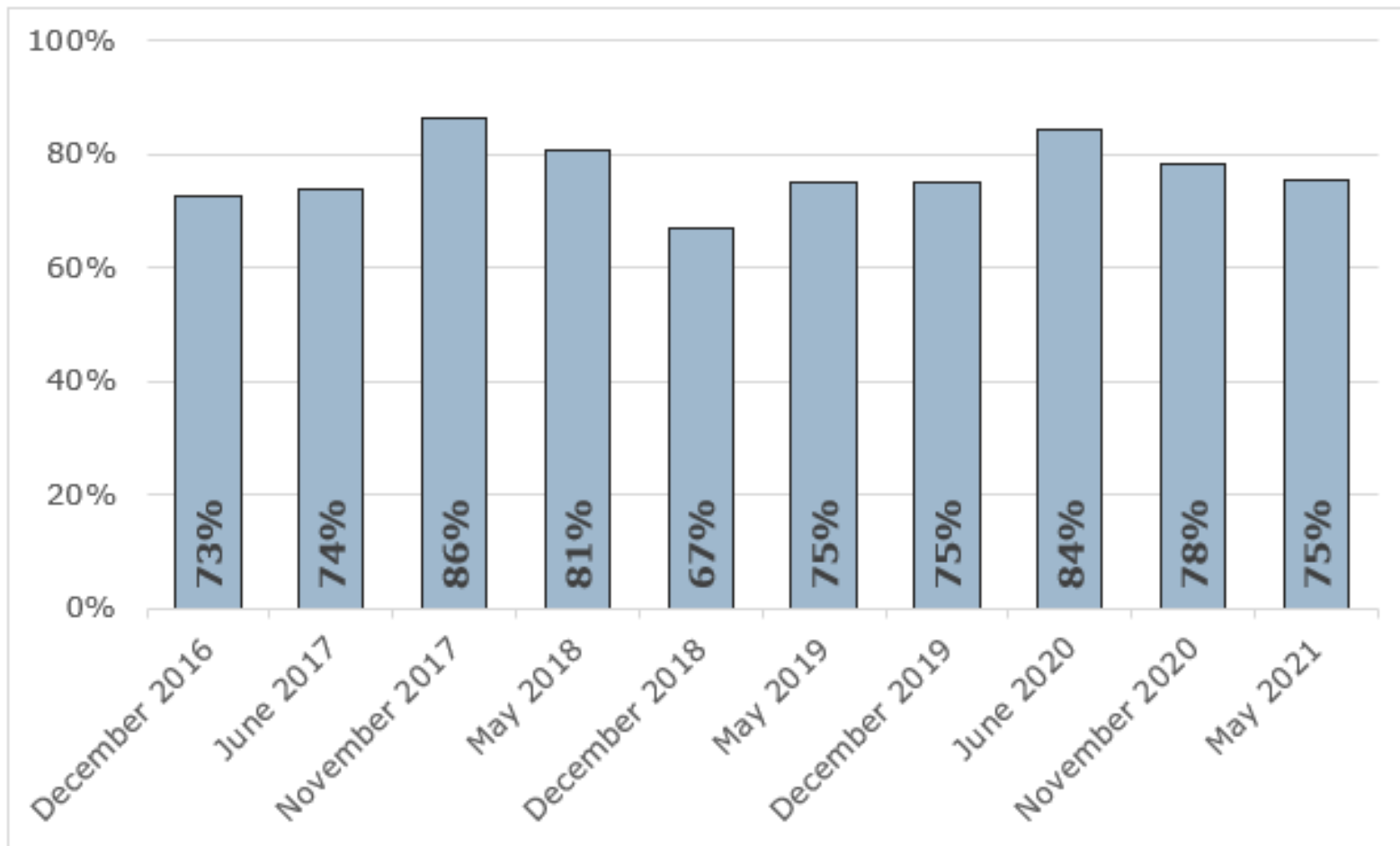




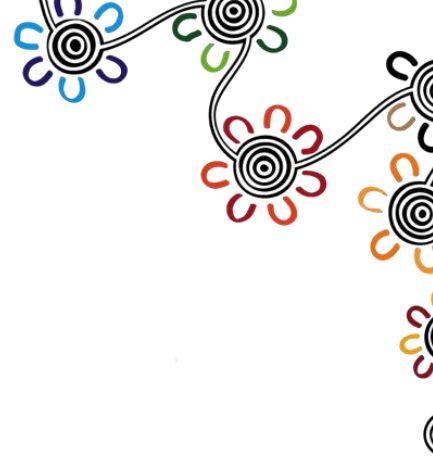
# Doing Things Differently

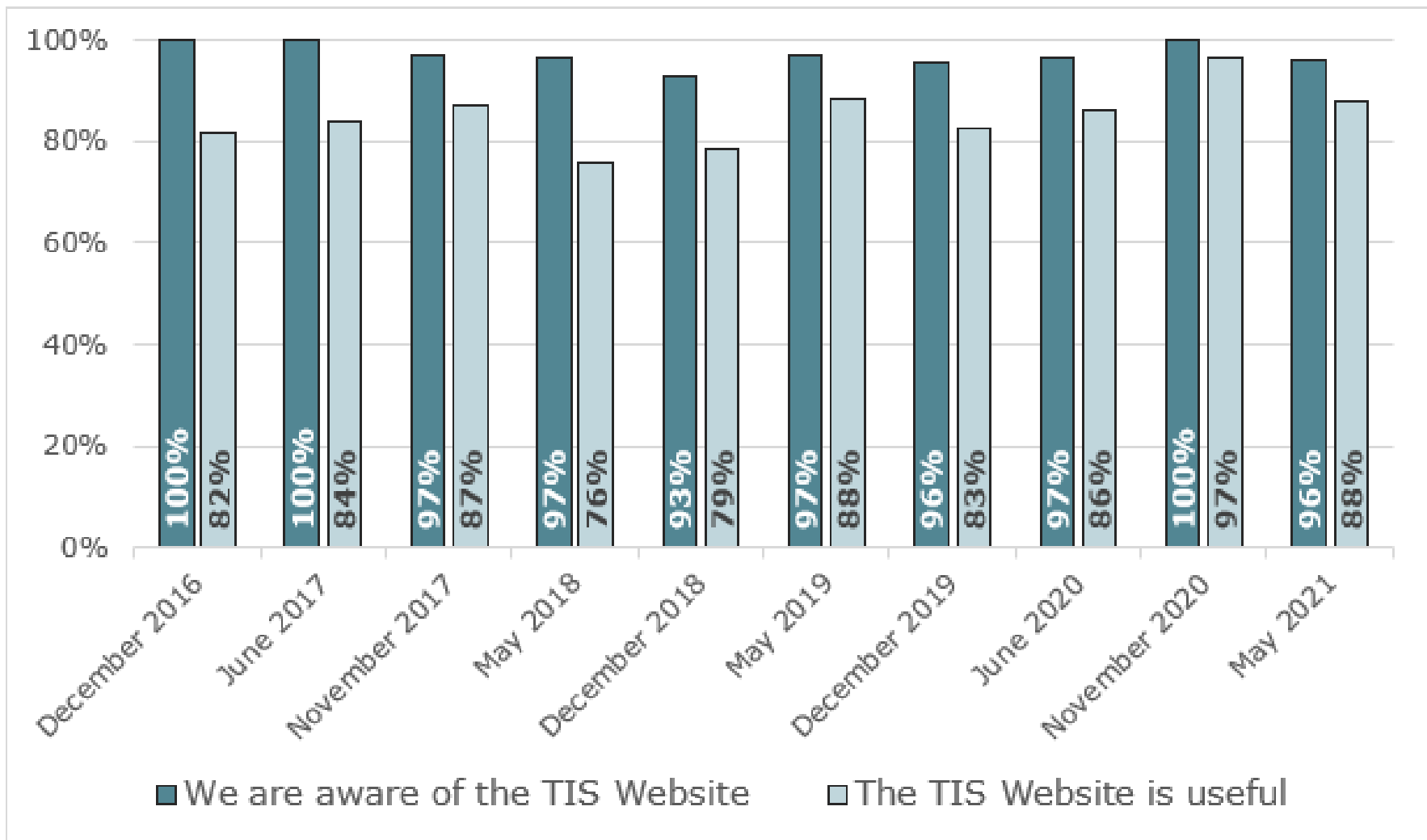

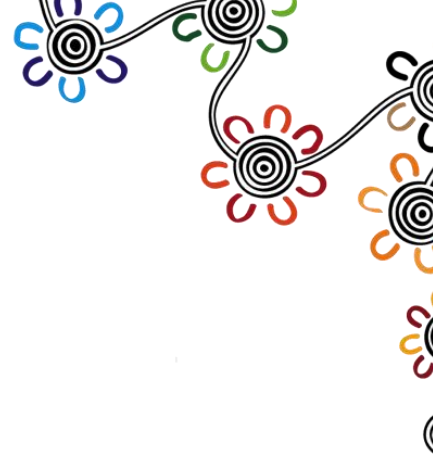
