TIS App - development

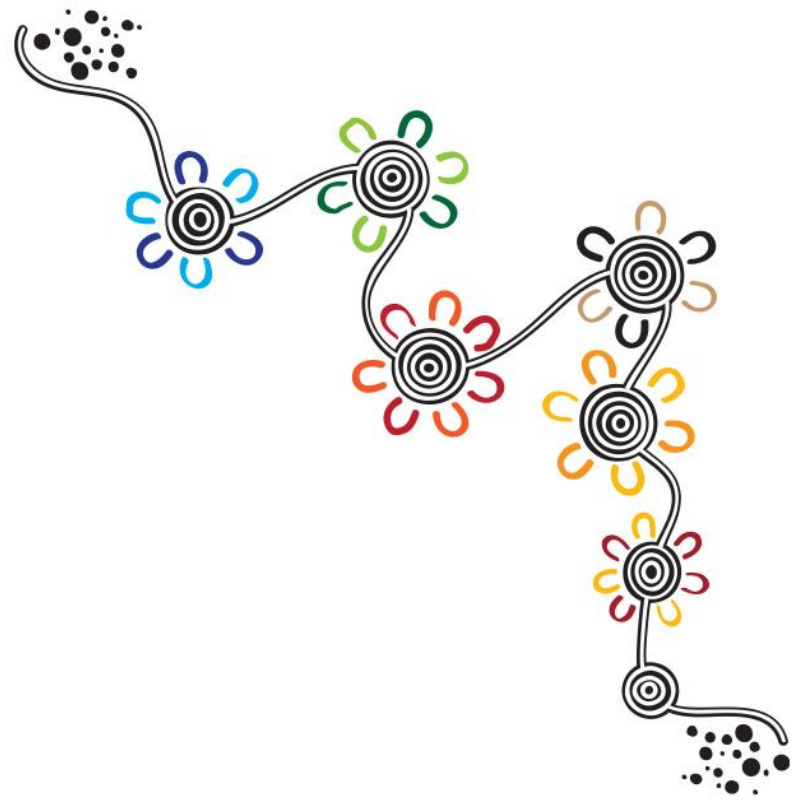


- Today: Mentimeter and brainstorming
